#### Format:

Players on the sideline from the teams playing will flip the score indicator on the table.

The winning team is responsible for reporting their score at the main tent right after their game.

10 minute games, running time off a central clock.

Goalies are neutral and make saves against both teams on the field.

After each goal, the team scored upon will get the ball (not make-it-take-it) and no throw.

If defense secures possession during play, the ball gets cleared back to the restraining line.

If the goalie makes a save, she will clear it to the current defensive team to clear it out.

An interception or other re-gain of possession by the attack while redefending does not need to be cleared.

In the Women's Division regular USL rules apply.

In the Co-Ed Division there is no stick checking, all other women's lacrosse rules apply.

If a player receives a card play is stopped, he or she leaves for 3 minutes and a sub may enter the game.

Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 for a loss

#### Tie Breakers:

Tied games will stand during the preliminary rounds.

For play-off placements, the first tie breaker is head to head result between teams tied (2 way tie).

The second tie breaker is cumulative goals against from the games among the teams tied (3 or more way tie).

The third tie breaker is cumulative goals against for all games played to that point.

The fourth tie breaker is a single elimination coin toss.

Once play is into the semifinals or further then ties must be played out to advance a team. First OT goal wins.

#### Winners:

The highest finishing high school team is the High School Division Champion.

The highest finishing women's team (high school or open) is the Open Division Champion.

The highest finishing co-ed team is the Co-Ed Division Champion.
