Due to the interest in Girls Lacrosse among our high school student athletes in our recruiting area and across the state of California, the Fullerton College Athletic Department will be fielding a Women's Lacrosse team in the Spring of 2019. Women's Lacrosse will be offered as a Club Sport initially and Fullerton College will work towards a CCCAA Intercollegiate sponsored sport. Pam Lewin has been very instrumental in bringing Women's Lacrosse to Fullerton College, without her efforts and persistence Women's Lacrosse would not be on our campus today. Pam is currently a full time tenured instructor in our Physical Education Division and also serves as our Women's Head Soccer Coach. Coach Lewin will service as our first Head Coach for Women's Lacrosse. Currently we have 16 players signed up for our fall Lacrosse conditioning class and some members of the current Women's Soccer team will be participating in the spring.

During the last year the following actions were done.

- Developed curriculum for Women's Lacrosse.
- Developed a four game schedule and seeking additional games.
- Allocated funds for equipment, uniforms, travel, coaching and other expenses.
- Granted membership as a Provisional team in the WWLL (Western Women's Lacrosse League).
- Recruited players and marketed program.
