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Sports Fees: Sports Fees paid to school: The participation fee to play a sport is \$125, even if a student played a fall and/or winter sport. A \$10 insurance fee is also required for lacrosse sport since it is not an OHSAA sanctioned as of yet. (This will change in 2017.)
