Paperwork & Fees : *All forms are to be turned in by the first practice, February 23. Failure to do so will result in the player being prohibited from practices until forms are turned in.*

1. Player Registration Form: Please complete the player registration form for each player. Game shorts (home/white and away/red) are mandatory and can be ordered on that form. They are the same style as the previous season. The mandatory shooter shirt can be ordered online at BSN Sports through the spirit wear order. You can also register to be part of the TWHS Boys Lacrosse Parents Club, cost \$35.

2. Physicals: A current physical form is required to be on file for all players. If your son participated in a fall and/or winter school sponsored sport, their physical form should already be on file. (Please make sure to check that it has not expired, needs to be dated no later than June 6th to cover the entire spring season). Make sure to keep a copy for your personal records.

3. Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drug Policies (ATOD page 1) form: if player didn't participate in fall or winter sport

4. Eligibility form (ATOD page 2): if a player didn't participate in a fall or winter sport

5. Lacrosse Waiver/Liability Form: Required for ALL players regardless if they have played another sport.

6. Concussion Form: Required for ALL players regardless if they have played another sport.

7. Emergency Medical Release – (No More Pink Cards!) Up to date Emergency Medical Release information is required to be submitted online through the Worthington portal. Medical releases will be printed by the school office and provided to the coaching staff. This form should have been completed during the back to school registration process, but please verify to make sure all information is current.

8. **Sports Fees paid to school**: The participation fee to play a sport is \$125, even if a student played a fall and/or winter sport. A \$10 insurance fee is also required for lacrosse. These fees will be paid online at www.mypaymentsplus.com after rosters have been entered by the AD's office in February. Athletic fees will automatically be adjusted for individuals qualifying for free or reduced lunch fees. Athletic fees are due by 2/28/15.
