

Directions To Different Santa Barbara Tournament Fields

Elings Park, Girsh Park, Polo Club, SBCC and UCSB

Surfaces

- Elings Park, Santa Barbara Polo Club, UCSB Harder Stadium and Storke Field are natural grass.
- UCSB RecCen Field, SBCC La Playa Stadium and Girsh Park are Field Turf.

Directions Using 101 South

- For all **UCSB** facilities exit on Los Carneros (after the Storke Road exit) and turn right.
- Drive straight through the Hollister Avenue intersection and then turn left at the next light onto Mesa Road.
- For the **RecCen Field Turf** continue straight on Mesa Road through a stop sign intersection at the campus Fire Station and turn right on Ocean Road. Park in Lot 16 or Lot 18 across the street from the field. Use either the structure (Lot 18) or the open air parking (Lot 16). Use a self-pay kiosk to get your parking permit.
- For **Harder Stadium** and **Storke Field** turn right on Stadium Road at a stop sign intersection in front of the campus Fire Station. Harder Stadium and Storke Field will be on your right at the crest of a short hill. Park across the street from the stadium in Lot 30 if the game is in Harder Stadium. Use a self-pay kiosk to get your parking permit.
- For **SBCC La Playa Stadium** exit 101 North on Bath Street and then turn left on West Haley Street. Drive under the highway and turn left on Castillo Street. Drive to a T intersection and turn right on West Cabrillo / Shoreline Drive. The stadium will be on your right. Turn right on Loma Alta Drive and then turn right into the stadium parking lot.
- For **Elings Park** exit Hwy 101 on Las Positas and turn right. Proceed through Modoc Road intersection and one more stoplight, then turn left into the park at 1298 Las Positas Rd, Santa Barbara, CA 93105 and drive to the upper fields. Website - <http://elingspark.org>.
- For **Girsh Park Turf** exit Hwy101 on Storke Road and turn right. Turn right on Phelps Road. The turf is at 7050 Phelps Road, Goleta, CA 93117. Website - <http://girshpark.org>.
- For the **Polo Club** exit Hwy 101 on Padaro Lane and turn left over the highway. Turn right on Via Real and proceed to 3300 Via Real, Carpinteria, CA 93013. Website – <http://sbpolo.org>.

Directions Using 101 North

- For **UCSB** facilities exit on Ward Memorial Blvd. (Highway 217), which ends at the campus.
- Turn right at the round about onto Mesa Road.
- For the **RecCen Field Turf** turn left at a stop light intersection on Ocean Road. Park in Lot 16 or Lot 18 across the street from the RecCen and the turf field. Use either the structure (Lot 18) or the open air parking (Lot 16). Use a self-pay kiosk to get your parking permit.
- For **Harder Stadium** and **Storke Field** proceed straight through the stop light intersection at Ocean Road. Turn left on Stadium Road at a stop sign intersection in front of the campus Fire Station. Harder Stadium and Storke Field will be on your right at the crest of a short hill. Park across the street from the stadium in Lot 30 if the game is in Harder Stadium. Use a self-pay kiosk to get your parking permit.
- For **SBCC La Playa Stadium** exit 101 South Castillo Street and turn right. Drive to a T intersection and turn right on West Cabrillo / Shoreline Drive. The stadium will be on your right. Turn right on Loma Alta Drive and then turn right into the stadium parking lot.
- For **Elings Park** exit Hwy 101 on Las Positas and turn left. Proceed through Modoc Road intersection and one more stoplight, then turn left into the park at 1298 Las Positas Rd, Santa Barbara, CA 93105 and drive to the upper fields. Website - <http://elingspark.org>.
- For **Girsh Park Turf** exit Hwy101 on Storke Road and turn right. Turn right on Phelps Road. The turf is at 7050 Phelps Road, Goleta, CA 93117. Website - <http://girshpark.org>.
- For the **Polo Club** exit Hwy 101 on Padaro Lane/Santa Claus Lane and turn right toward mountains. Make immediate left and proceed to 3300 Via Real, Carpinteria, CA 93013. Website – <http://sbpolo.org>.
