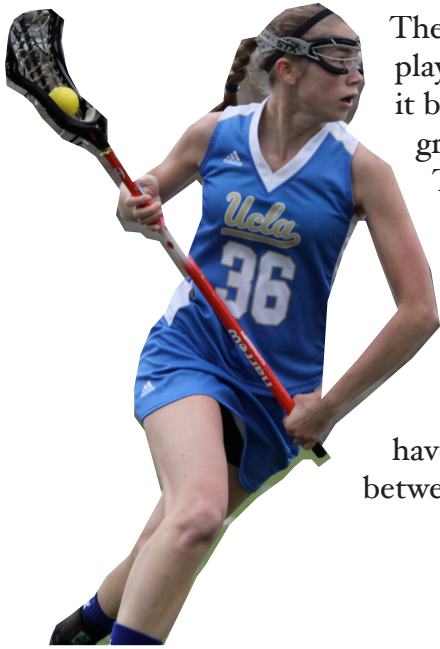

Women's Lacrosse presents: The 2012 Girls' Lacrosse Clinic at UCLA

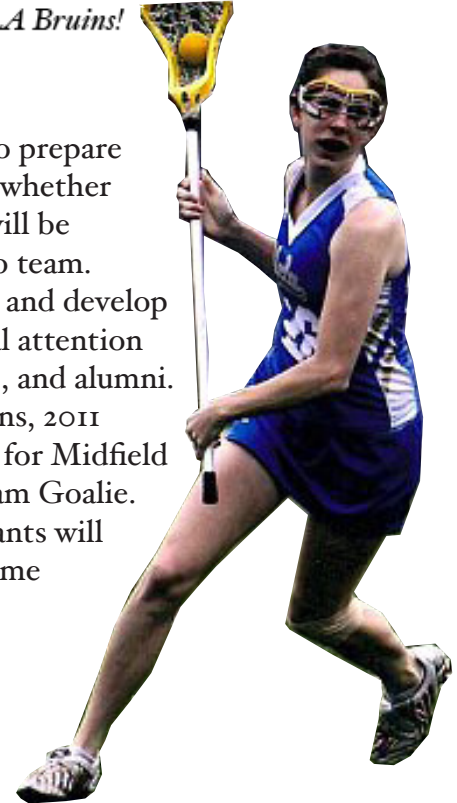
Hosted by the 2011 WCLA Division I National Championship Finalists, the UCLA Bruins!

Clinic instructors include WCLA All Americans, 2011 National Tournament Most Valuable Players for Midfield and Defense and the 2011 All-Tournament Team Goalie.

Immediately following the clinic, participants will have the chance to watch a full length exhibition game between the Bruins and their crosstown rivals, USC.
